Quick Facts About Your Destination:

CLIMATE

- Temperatures range from 77 – 80 F (25 – 27 C), and can fall to 66 – 74 F (19 and 23 C) during the winter
- The rainy season varies but you may regularly find rain sporadically during the months of May, June, and from September to November.
- Hurricane season (June-November) does affect this region.

CURRENCY

- Mexican Peso
- Most hotels and tourist attractions will take US dollars.
- Credit Cards are accepted at most major attractions, but for local shopping you may need Pesos or small American bills (\$1.00).

TIME ZONE: Eastern Standard Time

ELECTRICITY: Electric plugs are 110 volts

LEGAL DRINKING AGE: 18 years old

ENTRY / EXIT REQUIREMENTS

- All visitors must possess a valid passport

Destination Wedding Requirements:

- Birth Certificate of Bride and Groom or certified copy of Birth certificate. If parents' names are not shown on the certificates, please indicate them separately.
- Valid Passports of the Bride, Groom and 4 witnesses (This is essential, otherwise the wedding cannot be performed) PLEASE BRING THESE DOCUMENTS TO THE APPOINTMENT WITH YOUR WEDDING COORDINATOR
- Copy of the Tourist Visa Card of the Bride, Groom and 4 witnesses (This is given at the airport upon arrival to Cancun)
- Blood tests that should be taken in Mexico; they are not valid if it is taken elsewhere. To be considered valid the test should not be taken more than 14 days prior to the ceremony. The blood will be tested for HIV, RPR (sexually transmitted diseases) and blood type. The results will be ready in 24 hours and it will be given to the wedding coordinator to complete the paperwork. A \$300 USD + 16% tax, per couple, will apply for the Blood Test
- 4 Witnesses that can sign the legal forms 4 days before the wedding and during the ceremony. If you don't have the 4 witnesses arriving 4 days before the wedding, the resort will provide the witnesses
- Legal form completed with the names, addresses, nationalities, ages, occupation, relationship, for bride, groom. Please find attached the legal forms to be filled. It should be sent to the wedding coordinator 1 month prior the wedding date.
- Bride & Groom must be in the country 4 business days prior to the wedding (Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays DO NOT count).
